**Litopenaeus vannamei**



Shrimp is the most important marine species in foreign trade. Ecuador is the largest producer of captive shrimp in the Western Hemisphere and the second largest producer worldwide, after Thailand. 96% of shrimp production comes from farming and 4% from artisanal fishing. The main species is *Litopenaeus Vannamei*. On a smaller scale, other species are cultivated such as: *Litopenaeus Occidentalis*, *Litopenaeus Californiensis* and *Litopenaeus Monodon*.
